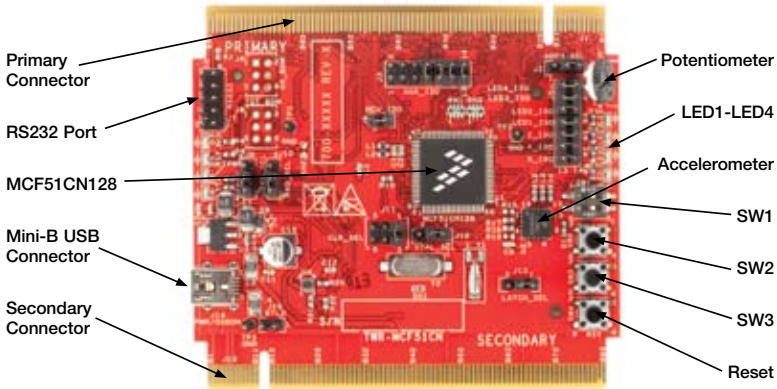

TWR-MCF51CN-KIT Freescle Tower System

The TWR-MCF51CN module is part of the Freescle Tower System, a modular development platform that enables rapid prototyping and tool re-use through reconfigurable hardware. Take your design to the next level and begin constructing your Tower System today.

Step-by-Step Installation Instructions

In this Quick Start Guide, you will learn how to set up the TWR-MCF51CN module and run the default accelerometer demonstration.

**STEP
1**

Install software and tools

- Install CodeWarrior™ Development Studio for Microcontrollers v6.2 (Professional Edition - 30 day license)*
- Install Processor Expert Update v3.06
- Install CodeWarrior Patch v6.2.2
- Install Freescale MQX™ RTOS v3.2

Install in the order listed. These programs are included on the DVD. For updates, please visit www.freescale.com/tower

*A Basic, Standard, or Professional version of CodeWarrior is required to run the MQX Lab Tutorials. CodeWarrior Professional 30-day evaluation is included on DVD.

**STEP
2**

Connect the USB cable

Connect one end of the USB cable to the PC and the other end to the mini-B connector on the TWR-MCF51CN module. Allow the PC to automatically configure the USB drivers if needed.

**STEP
3**

Tilt the board

Watch **LED1**, **LED2** and **LED3** light up as the TWR-MCF51CN module is tilted back and forth. Press **SW2** or **SW3** to see **LED4** light up.

**STEP
4**
