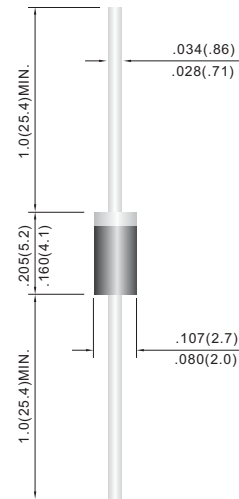

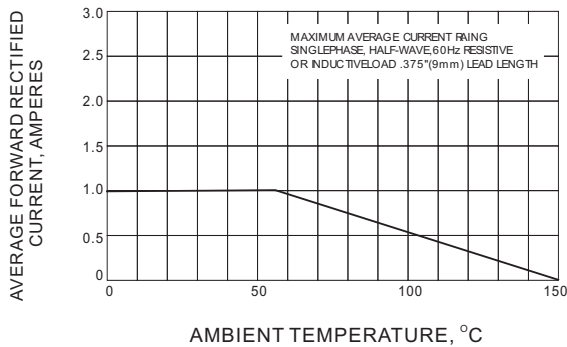


Fig.1 FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

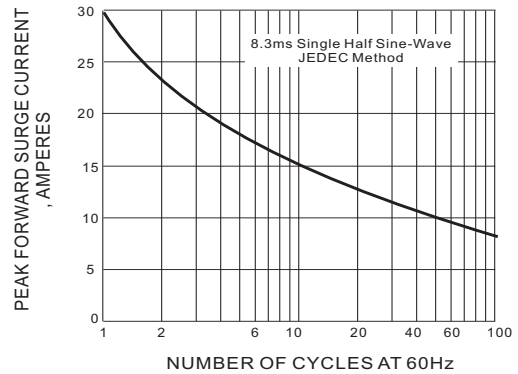


Fig.2-MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

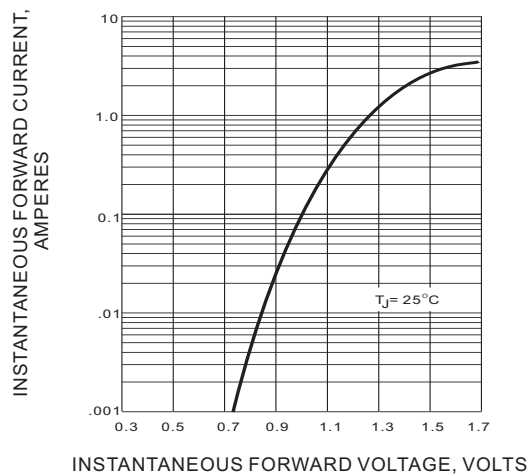


Fig.3-TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

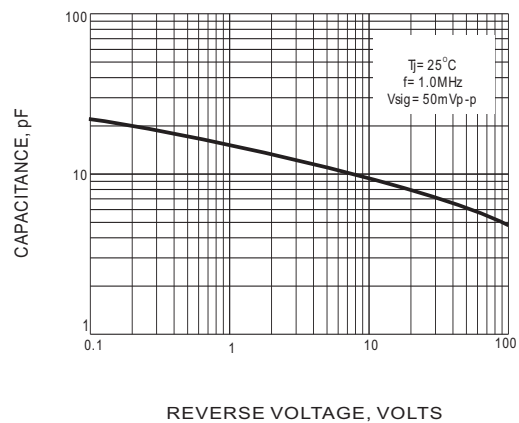


Fig.4 TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE

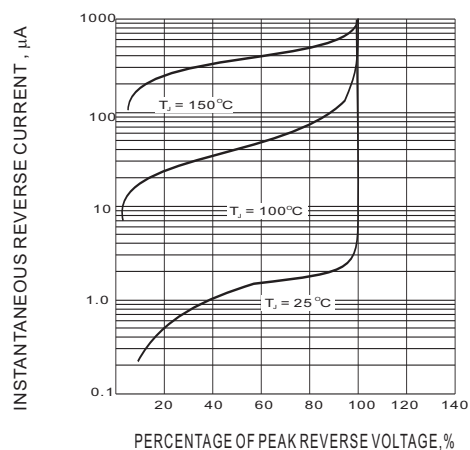


Fig.5-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTIC
