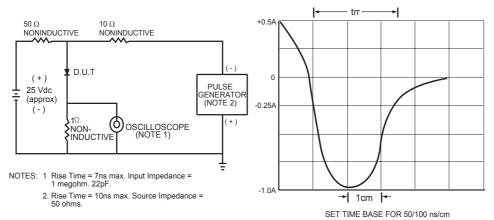

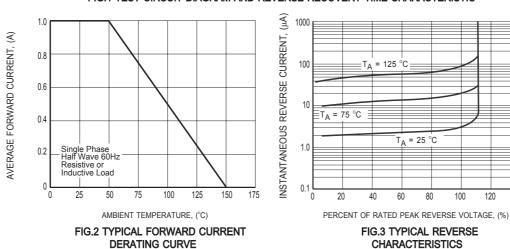

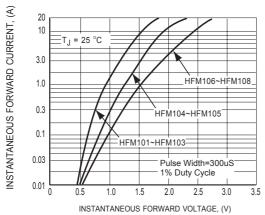


### FIG.1 TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM AND REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC

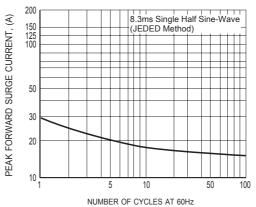
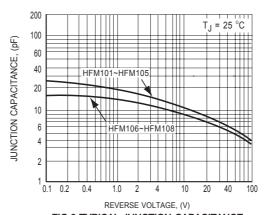


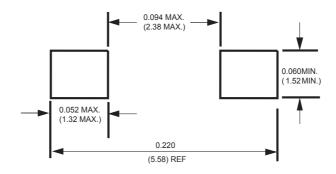
FIG.4 TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS
