## GaAs Integrated Circuit SPDT Switch for 1 GHz to 8 GHz

#### **DESCRIPTION**

The  $\mu$ PG2411T6R is a GaAs MMIC SPDT (Single Pole Double Throw) switch which was designed for 1 GHz to 8 GHz applications, including dual-band wireless LAN.

This device operates with dual control switching voltages of 1.8 to 3.6 V and can operate at frequencies from 1 GHz to 8 GHz, having the low insertion loss and high isolation.

This device is housed in a 6-pin plastic TSSON ( $\underline{T}$ hin  $\underline{S}$ hrink  $\underline{S}$ mall  $\underline{O}$ ut-line  $\underline{N}$ on-leaded) and is suitable for high-density surface mounting.





- C1 are DC blocking capacitors external to the device. The value may be tailored to provide specific electrical responses.

  antenna.






















## RFC-RF1/RF2 INSERTION LOSS, vs. SWITCH CONTROL VOLTAGE (H)



## RFC-RF1/RF2 ISOLATION vs. SWITCH CONTROL VOLTAGE (H)




#### RFC RETURN LOSS vs. SWITCH CONTROL VOLTAGE (H)




## RF1-RF2/RF2-RF1 ISOLATION vs. SWITCH CONTROL VOLTAGE (H)




#### RF1/RF2 RETURN LOSS vs. SWITCH CONTROL VOLTAGE (H)




## RFC-RF1/RF2 INSERTION LOSS, Icont vs. INPUT POWER

#### RFC-RF1/RF2 OUTPUT POWER, IM₃ vs. INPUT POWER






